**What Is Bullying?**

Deliberate, hurtful behaviour that happens a number of times.

**Three Main Types Of Bullying:**

Physical (e.g hitting or kicking)

Verbal (e.g name calling)

Indirect (e.g spreading nasty stories about someone)

**Signs Of Bullying**

If someone is being bullied they may feel shy and nervous. They will show changes in behaviour and lack concentration. They will also feel hurt.

**Do**

Tell an adult.  
Offer support.

**Don't**

Copy the behaviour.  
Join in.  
Encourage.

**School Procedure**

- Once an incident has been reported the member of staff will immediately deal with it.
- A clear account will be written down.
- Punishments will be used as appropriate.
- Parents will also be kept informed.
