| <p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>Ask your parents and grandparents about what holidays, travel and toys and games were like when they were children. If possible, film their answer and post it on tapestry so that you can show your class.</p> | <p><b>Mindfulness</b></p> <p>Practice finger tracing. Place your hand on paper or a sand tray. Starting at the base of the thumb, then trace the outline of your hand up around your thumb and around each finger. As you trace upward, breathe in. Practise singing it at home to perform for your friends at school.</p>                   | <p><b>We are scientists...</b></p> <p>Can you draw the human body and label the 5 senses.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The skin for touch.</li><li>- The nose for smell.</li><li>- The ears for hearing.</li><li>- The eyes for sight.</li><li>- The tongue for taste.</li></ul>  | <p><b>We are design technologists...</b></p> <p>Decorate cardboard cut-outs of people to look like your family members. Use fabrics, sequins, wool and other materials to create clothing and features. Can they recognise themselves?</p>  | <p><b>We are writers....</b></p> <p>Make a scrapbook with photos of the people in your family, including your parents and grandparents.
